

One STALYBRIDGE - STATION BUFFET BAR

This remarkable survival is situated at the West End of the Leeds platform underneath the railway clock. Step inside to enjoy the feel of an earlier age that is here still alive and well maintained.

In winter there is the comfort of a large coal fire; in summer you can sit outside and see the impressive hills. The bar serves hot drinks, traditional food (including pie and peas, black puddings and black peas) and a range of top quality traditional hand pumped beers. This buffet bar is a gem – it has appeared regularly in ‘The Good Beer Guide’ – and some people see no more than this bit of the town!

Just take the train from Eccles Station to Stalybridge.

Do remember that you will need to find the Manchester Platform to get home.
